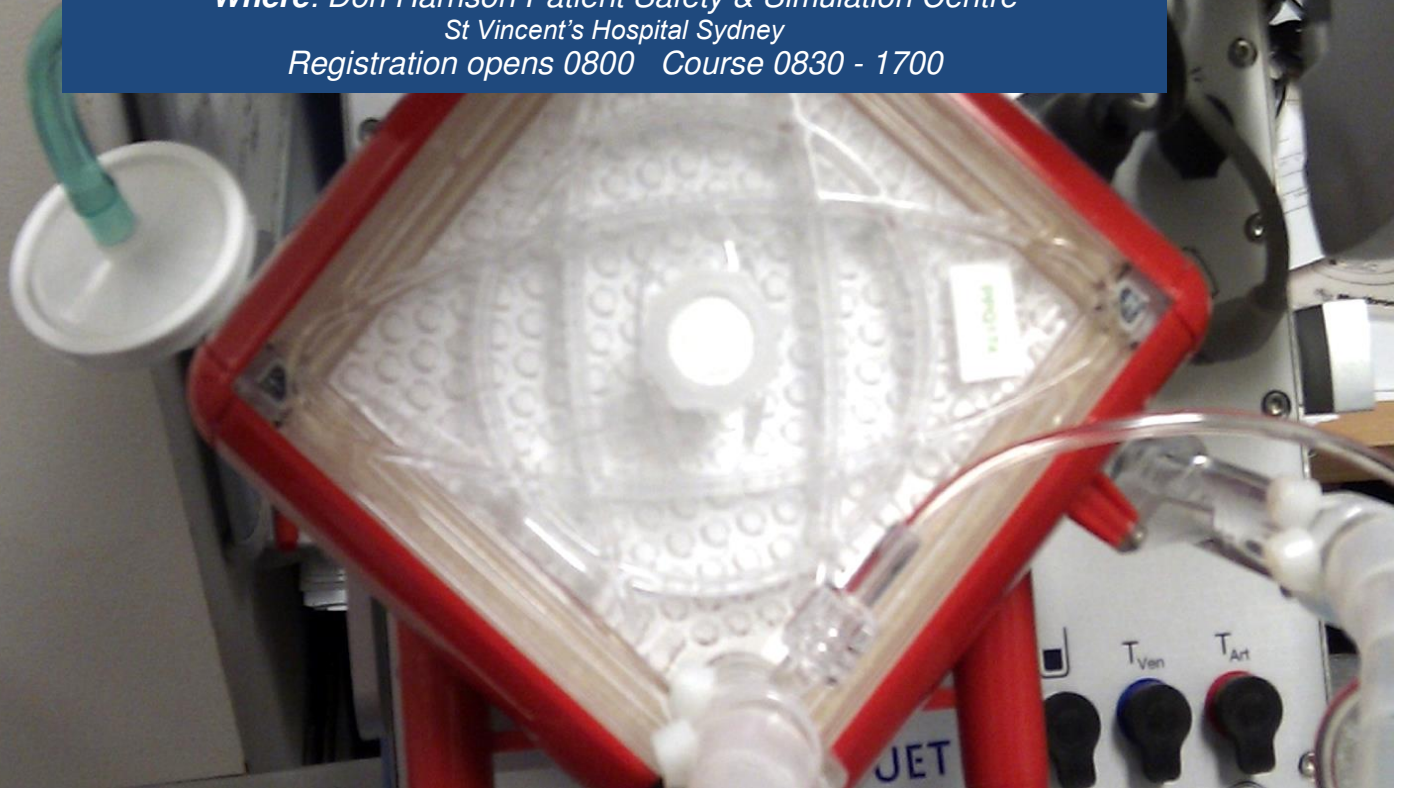


ICU Management of the ECMO Patient
